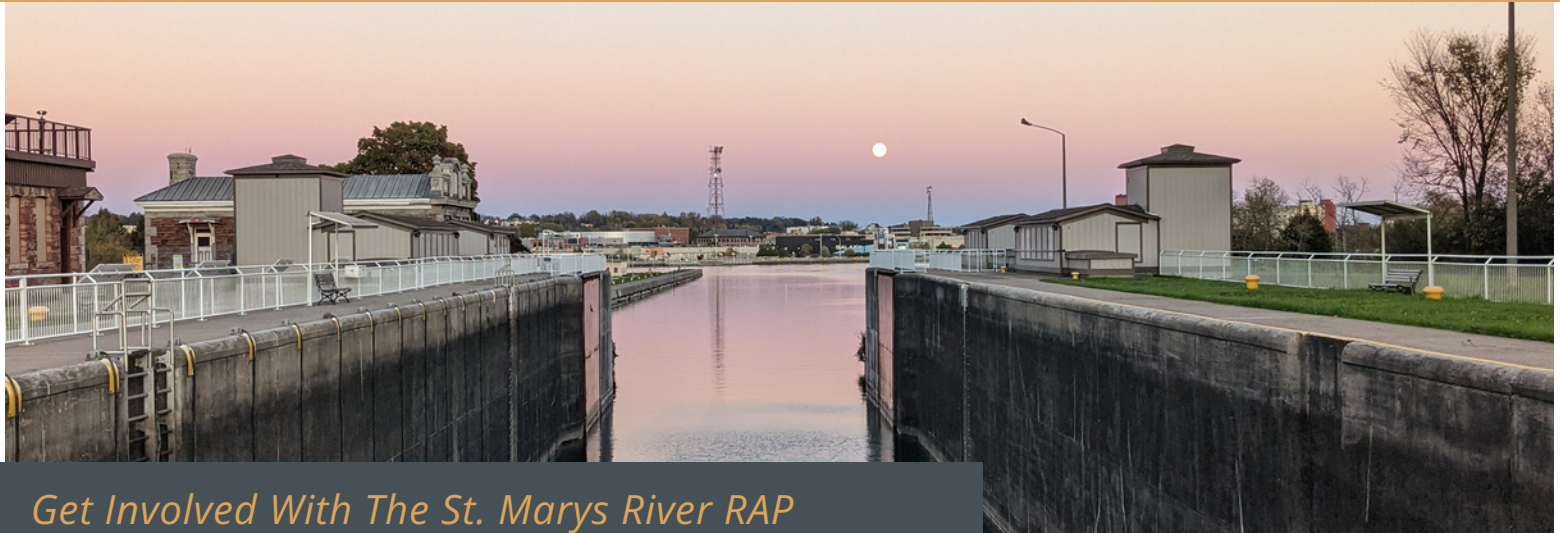

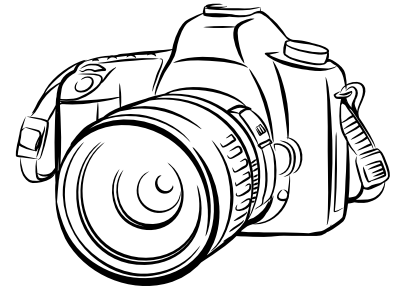
Get Involved With The St. Marys River RAP
